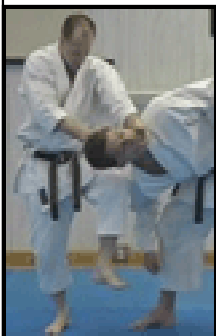


Kyoshi Frank Williams: 7-Dan

Kyoshi Williams began his training in 1971; he is a retired US Marine Corps Warrant Officer-4, the founder and President of the UMAA, and owner of two Karate dojo' in North Carolina. Kyoshi Williams lived in Okinawa for 13 years during his career in the Marine Corps, and trained under Fusei Kise Hanshi, Ed Gingras Kyoshi, Akamine Yoshimitsu Hanshi, and recently, Seifuku Nitta Hanshi.



Renshi Troy Price: 6-Dan

Renshi Price began training in 1982 under Ridgely Abel Hanshi, and began his jujutsu training under Steven Roensch Hanshi. Renshi Price has also trained extensively in TaiChi, BaQuaZhan, and Qi gong. He is the style representative and a member of the Board of Directors for the UMAA. Renshi Price has produced numerous instructional DVD's, and will have these DVD's available at the Gasshuku.



Sensei Garry Parker: 3-Dan

3-Dan Okinawa Goshukan-Ryu Karate, Kodokan Judo

Wu Zhu Chuan San Chien Form: Principles, Explosive power generation, and combative applications.

Iron Body Principles: Conditioning drills and mechanics.

Sensei Parker began training in Kodokan Judo in 1984 under Al Schmidt Shihan; He was stationed in Okinawa in 1991 and began training in Okinawa Goshukan-Ryu under Takamiyagi Hiroshi Hanshi- the founder. Sensei Parker lived and trained in Okinawa for 6 years, and is fluent in Japanese. He is the US Director for Okinawa Goshukan-Ryu. Sensei Parker has the distinction of being the first American promoted to black belt by the founder of Goshukan-Ryu, as well as opening the first authorized branch dojo outside of Okinawa.

There will also be demonstrations by several visiting Instructors and Senior martial artists, along with a special event: Goshukan-Ryu Shodan Grading/ Examination. This is an outdoor training camp; please bring towels and an extra keiko-gi/uniform and/or t-shirt.
